

## Philip and the Ethiopian Eunuch - worksheet

### Activity 1: Let's make a gospel book:

#### Equipment:

- . gold or yellow, red and Gold card or colour some paper those colours
- . fold them in halve
- . on the first red on
  1. Yellow (or gold) God is perfect and lives in Heaven
  2. Black— Our sin
  3. Red— Jesus' blood
  4. White— Jesus washes us clean
  5. Yellow (or gold) — growing in Christ (after accepting Him as your Saviour)

#### Special book using only colours.

**Gold** - represents heaven where Jesus came from and we all want to go

**Black** -our hearts have done lots of things wrong, these are called sins, God says our sins are like scarlet and it separates us from God.

**Red** - Jesus' blood, Jesus died to pay the price for us

**White** - Jesus has washed us clean on the inside, it's as if we have never done anything wrong.

**Gold**- we start our walk with Jesus now and it lasts forever.

The G.O.S.P.E.L Journey

Gold God created us to be and have relationship with him (Gen1-2) Black- Our sins separate us from him (Genesis 3)

Sins Cannot be Removed by good deeds (Isaiah 64:6)

Red- Paying the price for sin, Jesus died and rose again. (John 19:30)

White- Everyone who trusts in him alone has eternal life (1 John 5:11-13)

Gold- Life with Jesus starts now and lasts forever (John 10:10)
