

Jehoshaphat Goes to Battle - worksheet

Activity 1: Make a bottle shaker

Equipment:

- . One empty clean plastic bottle or jar for each person keep the top.
- . dried Peas or Lentils or sugar, even bits of Lego or anything hard and dry.
(maybe use a different substance per bottle).
- . something to decorate the outside of the bottle with. Paper, stickers, paint.
- . glue to stick or paint brush to paint.

Method:

- . Make sure the bottle is very clean inside and outside and make sure that it is completely dry inside.
- . Pour in the hard dry things that will make a noise.
- . Fasten the top very tightly by putting some strong glue around the edge before you screw the top on or put some strong tape on it afterwards as we don't want any small children finding the hard things inside and choking on them!
- . decorate the outside with paper or stickers or paint.
- . let it dry thoroughly.
- . gather the family and enjoy praising God together.

Activity 2: Have a loud praise and worship time with Your family.

Take turns to remind God what He has done that has been good for you.

Tell him that you have this problem and that you don't know what to do about it but know that He does; then praise Him some more.

(this will make you all feel happier, knowing you have trusted God).
