Read Luke 15:1- 7

- So what does this story tell us about God's love for us?
- What does this mean to you today?

The Lost Coin

Read Luke 15: 8-10

- How many silver coins did this woman have?
- Why did she ask her neighbours to celebrate with her?
- Try and remember when you could not find something special? How did you feel when you found it?
- We are sometimes like that lost coin when we stop listening to God. So why is this parable important to Us?

Talk with your adult about the ways you have seen God doing something this week. Maybe He did something in your life, or did something special in the life of your friend or a member of the family.

Perhaps it was when someone was kind to you.

Or you saw God through a sunset or when a bird sang.

Take a few minutes each day to thank God for what you have seen or heard Him do.
