

Kids' Corner - Joseph in Egypt

1. Why do you think he did that? Do you think you could do your best, if bad things were happening to you? Does God want us to do good all the time?
2. What did the butler dream?
3. How do you think the butler felt when Joseph interpreted his dream?
4. What did the baker dream? How do you think the baker felt when Joseph interpreted his dream?
5. How did Joseph know what the dreams meant?
6. How do you think Joseph felt as he waited longer and longer to hear from the butler?
7. Should we seek reward for helping others?
8. Should we alter the truth to make others feel better?
9. Sometimes God's time seems to take forever. What attitude should we have while waiting?
10. What important people did Joseph meet in prison? How do you think Joseph's years in prison affected him later?

Kids' Corner - Paper Lanterns

1. Start with rectangular sheet of paper. Cut a strip of paper from the long edge of the paper (about 1" width). This will be used as the handle of the lantern.
2. Fold the paper in half lengthwise. Cut strips crosswise: cut from the folded edge towards the raw edge. Be careful to keep the strips connected and do not cut each strip off.
3. Unfold the paper.
4. Loop the paper around to form a tube. Join the short ends of the paper together with tape or staples.
5. Tape or staple on the handle made in step 1 and you're done! You can make many of them and string them together - use a small piece of tape to keep them equal distance from one another.
